1. Corporate Name

The Canadian Society of Questers

4. Statement of the purpose of the corporation

The society seeks to correlate modern science with philosophies and metaphysics of various cultures throughout the ages.

The society seeks to understand and develop human mental and physical sensing capacities, and to inform interested others in unselfish, good purpose mind questing (a.k.a. divining dowsing, Radiesthesia or questing.)

The society seeks to encourage, assist and instruct those that seek a fuller understanding of the metaphysical, parapsychological and paranormal aspects of life.

The society seeks to develop the sensory and questing techniques if its members by studying parapsychology, diving, dowsing, radiesthesia and other quests, and by educating them in good-purpose mind questing.

6. The classes, or regional or other groups, of members that the corporation is authorized to establish

The society is authorized to establish one class of members. Each member shall be entitled to receive notice of, attend and vote at all meetings of the members of the corporation.

The society may establish regional chapters to act with the rights, privileges and responsibilities as periodically determined by the Board of Directors and approved by the membership.
